

Radio Fremantle - Radiothon 2024

Competition Terms and Conditions

1. Promoter

- a) The promoter is Creative Community Radio Inc (ABN: 80 590 148 721), herein referred to as its trading name of Radio Fremantle.

2. Eligibility:

- a) An Entrant is a single person. Businesses and corporations are ineligible but still welcome and encouraged to donate and support Radio Fremantle.
- b) Entrants must reside in Western Australia, have a valid Australian mobile phone or landline number, and a valid form of photographic identification in Western Australia (ie; Drivers License, Proof of Age Card, Senior Citizens Card or a Passport)
- c) Entrants must be aged 18 or over at the time of entry to be eligible to win the Prizes. Underaged entries are permitted but if deemed a winner, the prize will be awarded to a legal parent or guardian.
- d) Membership is not required for entry.
- e) Winners of an earlier draw of this competition are ineligible for subsequent draws and redraws. A maximum of one win is permitted per person for this competition.
- f) Entry is open to all, with the exception of members of the Radio Fremantle Board of Management, Contractors and Staff of Radio Fremantle.

3. Entry:

- a) A monetary donation of AUD \$2.00 or greater to Radio Fremantle is required to enter.
- b) Donations must be submitted via;
 - i. the online forms at radiofremantle.com.au
 - ii. by phoning a pledge through to the station and subsequently deposit by bank transfer.
 - iii. cash donation, made in person during office hours, to a nominated volunteer at the Radio Fremantle Office and issued with a receipt.
- c) Multiple donations per person are welcome, but only one entry to each daily draw, and the major draw per person is permitted.
- d) Entry is open from 07:00:00 on Monday July 1 2024 through until 23:59:59 on Saturday July 6 2024.
- e) Bank transfers not received before entries close will be ineligible for that specific draw, but entered into the daily draw for the following day until the end of the Radiothon.
- f) The number or amount of each donation has no effect on the number of entries or chance of winning an entrant will receive.

4. Prizes:

a) Draws:

- a) Daily: There are 6 daily draws for entries received between 00:00:00 through 23:59:59 on each day of the Radiothon competition;
 - i. Monday July 1, 2024.
 - ii. Tuesday July 2, 2024.
 - iii. Wednesday July 3, 2024.
 - iv. Thursday July 4, 2024.
 - v. Friday July 5, 2024.
 - vi. Saturday July 6, 2024.

- b) Major Draw: There is one major draw for all entries received between 00:00:00 on Monday July 1, 2024 through 23:59:59 on Saturday July 6 2024 that have not already won a Daily Draw.
- b) Each Daily Draw will be completed the following morning, after the day of the draw period as defined in 4.a.a. The major draw will be drawn after the completion of the Radiothon on Monday 8th of July 2024.
- c) Prizes:

- d) The total prize value for all prizes is \$1,500.
 - e) Prizes are gift vouchers and may be on-gifted to another family member or friend. Each winner will need to notify Radio Fremantle of such transfer.
 - f) No cash alternative is available.
 - g) Radio Fremantle reserves the right to substitute a prize with another of similar value if the original prize becomes unavailable.
 - h) No responsibility will be taken for failure to use the prize before an expiration date, closures, availability, condition or operating hours of the prize venue or any experience from the use of the prize.
5. Winner Selection:
- a) A minimum of 1 eligible entry received during the date range of a draw is required for each competition draw to take place.
 - b) The winner will be chosen at random from all eligible entries received for the draw date range.
 - c) In the event that no entries are eligible for any daily draw, the prize for that day will be forfeited and offered to a draw of any eligible entry from any day of the competition, at the end of the competition period after the major draw has been completed.
 - d) Any entrant with multiple eligible entries for a draw, will be given 1 (one) entry in that draw.
 - e) All draws will take place at the Radio Fremantle Office at Unit 4, 153 Rockingham Road, Hamilton Hill, WA 6163 during office hours.
 - f) Once drawn, an entrant is ineligible to win further draws during the competition period and any redraws that occur as part of this competition.
 - g) First attempts to notify the winner of each draw will be made by phone call on the day of the draw the subsequently and reasonably retried after that. Voicemail messages will be left where available.
 - h) Failure for a winner to be contactable within 7 days of a draw will result in a redraw of the prize, to be held on Monday the 15th of July 2024 at the Radio Fremantle Office during business hours.
 - i) If a winner declines their prize, it will be awarded to the next drawn entrant from the same draw group that the declining winner was selected from.
 - j) Any redraw winner will be subject to the same conditions with dates adjusted to reflect the same period of time for collection and acceptance.
6. Claiming and collecting the Prize:
- a) A winner must claim and collect their prize within 14 days of being notified.

- b) If the prize is not claimed within this period, a new winner will be drawn from the combined remaining eligible entries from all draws.
- c) Each prize will be awarded to the credit-card or account holder of the donation transaction only, or in the event of cash donations, the donor details given and noted on the receipt. Sighting of Credit Card used for donation and/or Photo ID may be required for collection.
- d) Collection must be made from the Radio Fremantle Office at Unit 4, 153 Rockingham Road, Hamilton Hill, WA 6163 during normal office hours only from an Employee or member of the Board of Management. General volunteers and announcers are not able to issue prizes from this competition.
- e) If a postal delivery of a prize is requested and approved by The Radio Fremantle Board of Management, the station accepts no responsibility for mail delivery, including loss or damage.

7. Publicity:

- a) By entering the competition, all Entrants agree to have their first name, the first initial of their surname, their suburb and their "donation message";
 - i. read on-air on Radio Fremantle 107.9FM and internet streams.
 - ii. published on the Radio Fremantle website at radiofremantle.com.au.
 - iii. published on the Radio Fremantle social media accounts.
 - iv. published on the social media accounts of individual shows aired on Radio Fremantle.
 - v. displayed with or without names on notices or documents produced by Radio Fremantle's Board of Management for the purposes of promoting the station and its activities within the community.
- b) Radio Fremantle and its announcers reserve rights to modify or reword an entrants message for grammatical or general decency reasons.
- c) Having a message read on air, published online or shared on socials is not a requirement for entry and does not offer any greater chances than those not publish or shared.

8. Liability:

- a) Radio Fremantle is not responsible for any technical, banking, financial or other issues that may affect entry into the draw.
- b) Any decision by the Radio Fremantle Board of Management is final in all matters relating to the competition, including those relating to eligibility and interpretation of these Terms and Conditions.

9. Privacy and use of collected data

- a) Personal data provided during the entry process will be used for the purpose of the competition and in accordance with the Policies and procedures, published on the stations website. It will not be made available to employees or members of the station other than for situations where deemed necessary, such as awarding prizes.
- b) If an Entrant accepts a subscription to the Radio Fremantle mailing list, their name and email will be added to the stations contact list for future communications about the station. A subscriber to these communications may unsubscribe at any time by clicking a relevant link in the email, replying to a newsletter email, or by calling the station during office hours and requesting such.
- c) Credit and Debit card data is processed by Stripe Inc and may be handled in countries other than Australia. Radio Fremantle only has access to the last four digits of a card number, the cards expiration date and the card issuer/type. The card data will only be used for the purpose of the donation transaction.

- d) Additional information provided by the Entrant for the purpose of this competition will be used in accordance with the policies and procedures, published on the stations website and those noted within these Terms and Conditions of Entry.

10. General:

- a) Refunds on donations are at the discretion of the Radio Fremantle Board of Management and may be returned only if valid reasoning is provided, less fees that the station incurred from any card processing or bank fees. All requests must be submitted in writing to The Board no less than 40 days after the transaction date.
- b) Radio Fremantle reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time with changes published on the stations website.

11. Acceptance

- a) By entering the competition, participants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
